

ONE MAINTENANCE ISSUE DOWN, ONE TO GO FOR THE BRIMFIELD COMMUNITY CUPBOARD



The Brimfield Community Cupboard would like to advise our friends of a maintenance situation that needs to be addressed at the Faith United Methodist Church where the Cupboard has been housed at no cost for 36 years. After many years of heavy truck and vehicle traffic, the asphalt driveways of the church have become badly deteriorated and are causing safety issues due to the possibility of someone tripping on the broken asphalt and the concern that ice will form in the pot holes this coming winter. The Cupboard has received donations that will pay for almost half of this project, but to complete the job before the weather turns bad, the Hometown Bank has graciously agreed to loan the Cupboard \$5,300.00.

The Cupboard will be conducting fund raising efforts to pay off this loan during 2016. Our first fund raising project is being sponsored by Sunny Hill Golf, of 3734 Sunnybrook Road in Brimfield, who has donated 100 golf tickets to assist the Cupboard with the asphalt project. For a \$35.00 donation to the Cupboard, you will receive a complimentary 18-hole golf game which includes a riding cart. The ticket is valid through May 15, 2016 and it will make an excellent Christmas gift for the golfers in your family. All donations are tax deductible and, in the event that the Cupboard receives in excess of the needed funds to pay for the asphalt, the balance will be used to purchase groceries for Brimfield residents needing assistance.
