Eagle Scout Jonathan Cramer's vision to create a community dog park in Brimfield has become a reality and will officially open Saturday, Sept. 3 at 10 am with a ribbon-cutting ceremony, Eagle Scout American flag raising, and K-9 demonstration.

In May of 2015, Jonathan Cramer brought his idea of creating the dog park as a service project before the Brimfield Township Trustees for approval. Jonathan didn't just pitch an idea, he presented drawings, photos, as well as names of businesses willing to help by donating materials. The trustees donated an unused parcel of land at Cranberry Creek Community Park for the project and Jonathan ran with it.

This project was made possible through the generous donations of area businesses and community members, and the many hours of physical labor the scouts put into the project. We wish to thank the following:
